On this the ____ day of _____, 20____, this agreement between the City of Canton Water System (COC) and _____ (Contractor) is entered into for the following fire hydrant meter:

Whereas, Contractor desires that the referenced fire hydrant meter be made available for the sole purpose of obtaining water service from available City of Canton Water System fire hydrants.

In consideration of the mutual agreement and promises contained herein, Contractor agrees as follows:

1. The Contractor shall be responsible for said meter and damages thereto, considering normal use.
2. The Contractor shall be responsible for payment of all fees accumulated, including, but not limited to the daily rental fee, until the meter is returned to the COC offices and rental agreement terminated.
3. **The meter should be returned to COC promptly upon completion of the work for which it is utilized; however, the meter must be returned within 90 calendar days from the date it is rented.**
4. **If the meter is lost, stolen, or otherwise not returned**, the Contractor shall be responsible for the cost of the lost/stolen equipment plus the daily rental fee and estimated usage of 500 gal/day accumulated until the City of Canton Utility Department is notified and rental agreement is terminated.
5. The Contractor agrees that the rates and fees in effect at the time of meter return shall be used to calculate amount due from water consumption.
6. The Contractor agrees upon becoming aware of a firefighting effort in the vicinity of the meter location, the fire hydrant meter shall be immediately disconnected from the hydrant.
7. The Contractor acknowledges that hydrant meters, when not in use, be disconnected from the hydrant and at no time will a hydrant meter be left unattended while affixed to a fire hydrant.
8. The Contractor acknowledges that meters shall not be moved to or used at any site other than the location disclosed in your rental agreement. All rentals are site specific and the use other than the disclosed location is expressly prohibited.
9. Hydrant meters must be available for consumption reading by the City of Canton each month. Contractor should call monthly with the current reading by 24th of each month.
10. The initial security deposit for this meter will be held until the meter is returned. Upon return, all applicable rates and fees will be calculated and deducted from the deposit.
11. The Contractor agrees to utilize and install the meter and related equipment in accordance with instructions given verbally by City of Canton Utility Department and the written instructions provided to Contractor's Representative.

The usage will be estimated at 500 gal/day on meters returned with negative consumption.
