Rules and Regulations

Personal transportation vehicle (PTV) means all electric and gasoline-powered pleasure carts, which are commonly called and referred to as golf carts, and are not capable of exceeding 20 miles per hour.

Personal Transportation Vehicle District (PTV-D) is a designated area approved by Canton City Council for the use of registered PTVs on approved 25 mph speed limit streets.

Minimal equipment required for PTV/insurance:

- (1) A braking system, including a parking brake;
- (2) An audible reverse warning device functional at all times when the directional control is in the reverse position;
- (4) Head and tail lamps;
- (5) Reflex reflectors and safety warnings;
- (6) A rearview mirror;
- (7) Hip restraints and hand holds.
- (8) PTV Owner/Operator is responsible for procuring liability insurance

Operating a PTV in a PTV-D:

- » PTV District speed limit is 25 miles per hour.
- » PTV is not allowed to travel on sidewalks, swales, trails, multi-use paths, or bicycle paths.
- » PTV should not exceed the manufacturer's recommended seating capacity.
- » PTV driver must have a valid motor vehicle instructional permit and be at least 15 years of age to operate a PTV in a PTV-D. If under 18 years of age, the PTV driver must be accompanied in the front seat by a person who holds a valid motor vehicle driver's license and is at least 18 years of age.
- » PTV driver should follow all state traffic laws and regulations, and all laws and ordinances related to alcohol.

Registering a PTV for River Green PTV-D:

One-year registration is \$15. Must be 16 years of age and older to register a PTV. Decals provided upon proper registration from the City of Canton must be affixed to the sides or windshield of the PTV.
